**RE: RAW AND RECYCLED MATERIAL CONTENT**


To Whom It May Concern,

This is to confirm that Horton aluminum door units are manufactured using 100% primary material (billet). Aluminum billet containing a significant percentage of post-consumer recycled content results in extrusions with an inferior surface finish that does not meet the aesthetic requirements of the architectural community, or the quality expectations of our customers.

All excess post-manufactured materials (scrap) are 100% recycled.

Horton door units can be disassembled and recycled after use. Materials not recyclable using current commercial processes are essentially inert after manufacture and can be safely disposed of at end of their service life without adverse impacts on water, soil, or air quality.

Additionally, Horton product is shipped in environmentally friendly recycled cardboard (OCC) that can be further recycled or reused.
